## Ebola Update: August 7, 2014

## EBOLA ALERT - 7th August, 2014

- The CDC (Centre for Disease Control and Prevention) has raised its alert level to 'Level 1 Activation' following the spread of the disease to Nigeria. 'Level 1 Activation' is the highest level possible, and is applied to only the most serious of public health emergencies. This is the first time this level has been reached since the Avian Flu threat in 2009.
- Liberia has declared a 'State of Emergency' that will be in effect for 90 days. Troops are being deployed to guarantine affected areas.
- Security forces have begun to quarantine the Kenema and Kailahun districts in eastern Sierra Leone. This quarantine will be in effect for at least 50 days.
- A Saudi citizen has died in Jeddah of an apparent Ebola infection after a business trip to Sierra Leone.
- Spanish authorities have today evacuated a Spanish citizen with Ebola from Liberia to Madrid. This
  follows the evacuations of two US citizens by American authorities earlier this week.
- We recommend suspension of all nonessential travel to Sierra Leone, Liberia and Guinea.
